AP EXAM SCHEDULE

For the information of those students who signed up to write AP exams in May, the schedule is attached. Please note that some exams are being written at other school sites in Richmond. If you are writing an AP exam, parents are asked to contact the school office to excuse them from their classes at that time they are writing the exam(s). Students should also communicate directly with their teachers to get any work they may be missing. Students may choose not to write their AP exam(s). Parents of students who choose not to write their AP exam(s) will receive a refund for each exam not written once exams are completed. Note that there is a \$55 penalty charged for each AP exam not written. That fee will be deducted from the refund parents will receive.

INTIMATE IMAGES PROTECTION ACT

The Intimate Images Protection Act (IIPA) provides a pathway to legal action for victims who have had their images distributed without consent. The IIPA supports a new process to have images taken down and seek damages through the Civil Resolution Tribunal (CRT).

A new service, the Intimate Images Protection Service ([link](#)), supports people who have had their intimate images shared, or threatened to be shared, without their consent. The Service provides emotional support, resources, and information about how to get intimate images removed. They can also help with applications to the Civil Resolution Tribunal or other reporting processes.
