### **NOV 17/17 Queens University Chancellor's Scholarship Nomination ~ In-School Deadline**

The Queens Major Admission Award (Chancellor's) is valued at \$36,000 (\$9,000 x 4 yr) scholarship. The Chancellor's Scholarship requires nomination to be considered. The number of nominations is dependent on the graduation school population. Complete a reference letter form and forward to your counsellor by the in-school deadline. The criteria for this scholarship is: superior academic ability 90+% average, and demonstrated leadership and original thinking. If selected for nomination, you will be asked to complete the application.

In order to allow enough time to access the online Major Admission Award Application (MAA), Queen's is recommending out-of-province students apply via OUAC by around Oct 15. For details visit:
