Capilano to launch new “Cap Core” initiative beginning Fall 2018

Capilano University has announced that it plans to restructure how its degree programs approach their students' electives starting this fall with a new program called Cap Core. Cap Core is divided into three sections - Foundation, Integration and Professional Practice - and students spend half of the 30-credit program studying courses from outside of their area of study. Cap Core is a framework to help students select and tailor coursework, and is designed to provide both the foundational and professional knowledge for success in a chosen career. All students beginning their baccalaureate degree studies in Fall 2018 or later are required to complete the Cap Core curriculum as part of their program. Capilano University ~ Self-reporting Information

If you are a current grade 12 high school student studying the BC or Yukon curriculum who has submitted an application for the Fall 2018 term you can self-report your grades from January 15th to March 31st, 2018.

*Note, if you are a student in a semester school, you are encouraged to wait until March to self-report, as all of your grades are needed, not just semester one grades. Note that you have 30 minutes to self-report your grades. Be sure you have sufficient time to complete the process before you start. You cannot save your work and return to finish later.
