KPU ~ Health Foundations Prerequisite Changes

- **Biology 12 has increased from "C+" to "B"**
- **Chemistry 11 has increased from "C+" to "B"**

The purpose of the part-time/full-time Certificate in Health Foundations (HF) Program is to provide foundational health courses which prepare students with knowledge and skills necessary to enter the second year of a KPU nursing degree program. This is a limited enrollment program with intakes in each semester. Upon application to the Health Foundations (HF), students will indicate one of two streams:

- Pre-nursing
- Pre-psychiatric nursing

Students who complete the program requirements may apply to graduate with a Certificate in Health Foundations. Through a competitive process, students may continue three additional years ~ Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) or Bachelor of Psychiatric Nursing (BPN) degree, or may move to another program/faculty at KPU.
