University/College Offers of Admission:

Grade 12 students who have applied to a university/college for entry in September are reminded to regularly check their institution's secured student website/portal for new messages. These sites contain important details regarding transcript submission, self-reporting, admission offers, course pre-requisites, registration, deadline dates, contact information, grades, etc.

Planning to attend a Post-Secondary college/university....

Accepted your offer of admission - now what?

Make sure you closely follow your post-secondary school's instructions and pay your deposit, before the deadline, to confirm acceptance. Many colleges and universities offer important workshops for new students, such as:

- ~First year course planning
- ~Registration "how-to"
- ~Tips for success
- ~Campus Services

Visit your university/college portal for specific details.

Post-Secondary Course Registration Date/Time

Grade 12 students...you are reminded to check your college/ university student account for **your** course registration date and time. **Plan ahead**...prepare/review a variety of timetable options in advance of your specific registration date/time. Your first timetable choice may already be full, so it is wise to have a number of timetable or course options prepared to consider, as an alternate.

Applying for a Student Loan?

Early June 2018 Student Aid BC applications open. Note that the process for applying for a student loan has changed for 2018.
