## 1. \*NEW\* Early Childhood Education Assistant Certificate

\*Information Session – Thursday, January 19<sup>th</sup> 6:30 – 7:00pm on Zoom (use link above)

- Runs July 4<sup>th</sup> 28th (full-time) in summer between Grade 11/12
- Students earn both high school and post-secondary credits (dual credit)
- FREE program TUITION for the ECE courses
- This program is designed to develop and enhance practical skills, increasing students' knowledge for a successful ECE career.
- Students will obtain daycare work experience during the program
- A partnership between SD38 Career Programs and Delta Continuing Education\* (\*a provincially certified training institution for ECE Basic and Post-Basic Certifications)
- ECE Applications due March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023 (Gr 10/11's apply)

## 2. \*NEW\* Manufacturing and Engineering Co-op (MEC)

\*Information Session – Thursday, February 9<sup>th</sup> 6:30 – 7:00pm on Zoom (use link above)

- Runs Semester 2 mornings (1st three blocks) @ Burnett Secondary; last block at home school
- Earn three high school courses = 12 credits (Grade 11/12 level)
- Includes Work Experience in the manufacturing industry
- Option to earn an industry certification through North West Skills Institute
- Learn about concepts and applications in engineering, machining, manufacturing and fabricating
- MEC Applications due March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023 (Gr 10/11's apply) (on our website)
