# 2. Ticket Sale Update

Ticket price has been set at \$110 to account for inflation costs of the event. DAG tickets are no up on the Cash Online System. 43 tickets have been purchased to date. Parents/caregivers have the option to pay the full amount or offer installment options to ensure that paying for the event is not a burden for families. Anyone who requires financial support for their child to attend graduation events should contact Mr. Johnstone/school counsellors directly to request assistance. All requests will remain anonymous.

Accommodations will be made for students who require it to ensure that everyone can participate. Parents/caregivers/students should connect to Jeff Johnstone to discuss specific needs and this information will be communicated to the committee to work out logistics if necessary. Accommodations may include private changing areas, additional staff/volunteers/adults to support attendee during the event

Students not attending DAG but attending the dinner/dance travel to Vancouver on a separate bus which will arrive back to the school and unload students in a different area than those arriving for DAG event.

Coach buses have been booked for transportation from the school to the Fairmont Waterfront Dinner/Dance venue and back to the school on Tuesday, June 27<sup>th</sup>.

**Decorations Committee** – Dionne McFie and Paige Northrup have agreed to Chair this committee. Given that they are already committed to co-chairing the Red Carpet/Entertainment committee, we are looking for help on these committees to share the work load.

The theme for the event was announced at the meeting. This information will not be included in minutes to ensure that the grads don't find out in advance of the event. The theme is a surprise for the graduates.

Hoping to have access to the school starting on Friday, June 23<sup>rd</sup> evening or Saturday, June 24<sup>th</sup> to start set-up for the event.

**Red Carpet Committee** - More parent volunteers are needed to help with set-up the red carpet and photo booths on Tuesday, June  $27^{\text{th}}$ . These can be grade 10/11 parents. There will be 4 student photographers to take photos at the photo booths.

**Entertainment Committee** – the entertainment is all booked including a DJ. We are in need of a Henna/Tattoo artist for the evening on June 27<sup>th</sup> into 28<sup>th</sup> 11:30 pm to 3:45 am. Please let us know if you have any connections for a Henna artist.

**Transportation Committee** – coach buses have been booked. In need of 10 bus chaperones that are grade 11/10 parents (not grade 12 parents)

**Security Committee** – Genesis Security is booked for the event. Will need 10 parent volunteers for the night of the event June 27<sup>th</sup> 11 am – June 28<sup>th</sup> 5:30 am. Overall it was a good experience last year. Typically, grads don't want their parents at the DAG event so we will be relying on Grade 11 and 10 parents for Security.

**Donations Committee** – Currently \$38 raised from the bottle drive (Return-It program). Inquiry made about online donation.

We require someone to look into how we apply for the Dry After Grad program through BC Liquor Stores.

# **Fundraising Committee** – we have not had anyone step forward to chair this committee. A fundraising committee would assist with soliciting donations to off-set the hard costs of the event. This could include cash donations, or in-kind donations/discounts on items that we'll be purchasing for the event.

Lighting Committee – re-introduction of Akber Dhanjee who is kindly donating his time and expertise for lighting and parking even though his children graduated many years ago.

Take Down Committee – no update.
