The Spring Break Camp Leader is responsible for delivering this program independently under the supervision of the Educational Programs Coordinator. Responsibilities include:

- » maintaining a positive and healthy learning environment
- » maintaining active supervision, especially during field trips
- » liaising with Museum staff and parents
- » providing direction to volunteers
- » evaluating and providing feedback about this program

Qualifications:

- a minimum of 2 years experience supervising groups of 10+ children;
- a minimum of 3 years of post-secondary education in museum studies, history or education, and/or related experience in a museum, heritage or a cultural setting;
- enthusiasm for working with children; and
- passion for history, culture and museums.
