GRADUATION NUMERACY ASSESSMENT – April 24-26

As part of the graduation requirement, all Grade 10 students are required to write the Graduation Numeracy Assessment (GNA). The Numeracy Assessment is a provincial assessment that assesses student proficiency in numeracy. The focus of the assessment is on the application of mathematical concepts learned across multiple subjects from kindergarten to Grade 10. It requires students to solve problems by using five numeracy processes (different ways of thinking and working): interpret, apply, solve, analyze, and communicate.

At McMath, the **GRADUATION NUMERACY ASSESSMENT (GNA)** is scheduled for **April 24 – 26**. All current Grade 10 students are registered to write the GNA on these three days. Writing times and locations will be posted on our website and outside the office.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT EXAMS

Students signed up to write Advanced Placement Exams, please see the attached schedule. It is the student's responsibility to organize their own transportation to and from and exams that are offsite.
