POST SECONDARY

- *"Keep Calm AND Carry On"....we are here to support*
- Applications typically open in the early Fall. Some institutions have set days each year, for example SFU, Langara and KPU applications open as of October. 1. UBC opens in early October. For non-competitive programs at Kwantlen or Langara, it is important to apply as early as possible. Deadline for application is usually in January or February, and varies with institution and program.
- Admission is based on grades (highly competitive) and may include a supplemental application (eg. personal profile or "broad-based application") for a holistic perspective about you.

Supplemental Documentation

In addition to your academic performance, Canadian universities will sometimes consider supplementary information such as a written personal profile, a video or portfolio. Recommendations or reference letters are generally not required.

Supplemental Information Includes:

- Personal essay outlining WHO YOU ARE, special aptitudes or interests
- Extra-curricular activities
- Academic achievements
- Teamwork skills
- Leadership
- Other accomplishments, problem solving

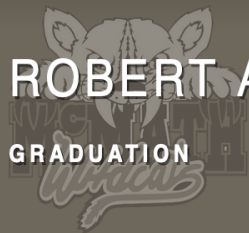
