- 5) How to change your password
 - Click on your name in the top right corner and select “Set Preferences” then choose security and select change password.



- 6) Your new password must satisfy the following criteria.

- Minimum length is 8
- At least one number
- At least one capital and lowercase letter
- At least one symbol that isn't a letter or number
- Can't contain 'password', login name, first name, middle name, last name, date of birth, personal id, or only sequential letters or numbers

- At the login screen, click “I forgot my password” and answer the security question. Your password will be sent to your email address listed on MyEd.
