2024-2025 GRADES 8-11 COURSE

VERIFICATION: April 16-18th

Students in Grades 8-11 are asked to login to your MyEducation BC account to review your course selections for the 2024-2025 school year. (Click on the "My Info" top tab > Click on the "Requests" side tab).

Please check to make sure that your course requests are correct. The timetable will be built based on all students' course requests currently in the computer. Changes will be difficult to make once the timetable is built so it is important that you check your course requests for accuracy.

All students must complete and submit this form by 3pm Thursday, April 18, 2024 at

https://forms.office.com/r/iDHFQpwm7g . The form will be open from April 16-18, 2024.

This is the <u>last opportunity</u> for you to make changes to your course requests as we move forward to build the timetable.

IMPORTANT NOTES & REMINDERS

- (1) All students entering Grades 8-11 should have a minimum of 8 McMath course requests. All students entering Gr 12 should have a minimum of 7 McMath course requests.
- (2) The courses listed are <u>requested courses only</u>, they are not guaranteed. Conflicts in the timetable, course cancellations, selected entry course determinations, or oversubscribed courses may require the use of your requested alternates. All students will receive a list of their scheduled courses in August.
- (3) Course requests are prioritized to students who are currently in the grade level of the course requested (for examples, a Gr 12 student requesting English 12 is a higher priority than a Gr 11 student requesting English 12).
 (4) If you are planning to complete a course through Academic Completion Summer Learning and/or Academic
- (4) If you are planning to complete a course through Academic Completion Summer Learning and/or Academic Full Credit Summer School (in-person or online), the same course should not be listed as one of your course requests.
