****NEW** BIOMEDICAL AND HEALTH SCIENCE FOUNDATION PROGRAM @ KPU** Semester 2 (Mon-Fri full-time @ KPU Surrey)

Pre-requisites (by program start) and Attributes

- must have completed English 12 by start of program
- Biology 11 or 12 (min "C") recommended
- Chemistry 11 or 12 (min "C") recommended
- registered in SD38 and entering Gr 11 or 12 in September
- students may attend all Gr 12 grad events at home school while at KPU

Program Features

- Program will include four university transferable courses: Introductory Biology 1 (BIOL 1110), Anatomy & Physiology 1 (BIOL 1160), Intro to Psychology (PSYC 1100) and Intro to University Writing (ENGL 1110)
- Get a head start on a biomedical, health science or nursing degree while in high school

What You Will Earn

- KPU – 14 university (transferable) credits
- High School: 16 credits (4 elective courses) at Grade 12 level

Must be a Canadian citizen or hold a valid PR Card to apply for these.

POST SECONDARY

- *"Keep Calm AND Carry On"....we are here to support*
- Applications typically open in the early Fall – some open now. Some institutions have set days each year, for example Langara and KPU applications open as of October 1st. UBC & SFU opens in early October. Deadline for application is usually in January/February and varies with institution/program. For non-competitive programs at VCC, Kwantlen or Langara, it is important to apply as early as possible.
- Some admissions are based on the academic transcript only (highly competitive). Some admissions consider academic transcript PLUS an academic profile (e.g. supplemental application, personal profile) for a holistic approach for evaluation – a “broad-based application”. *Quality* of application is reviewed.

Supplemental Documentation

In addition to your academic performance, Canadian universities will sometimes consider supplementary information such as a written personal profile - essay questions, a video or portfolio. Recommendations or reference letters are generally not required.

Supplemental Information Includes:

- Personal essay outlining WHO YOU ARE, special aptitudes or interests
- Extra-curricular activities
- Academic achievements
- Teamwork skills
- Leadership
- Other accomplishments, problem solving, resilience



ONLINE APPLICATIONS

- Consider choices & prepare
 - Research Careers/Programs/PSI
 - “Profiles” - supplemental, personal profile
 - Scholarship essays
- Apply to at least 2 schools
 - Keep “some” options open – backup plan
 - Many programs are competitive

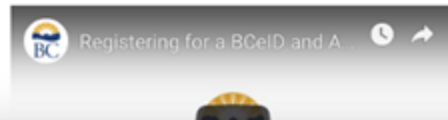

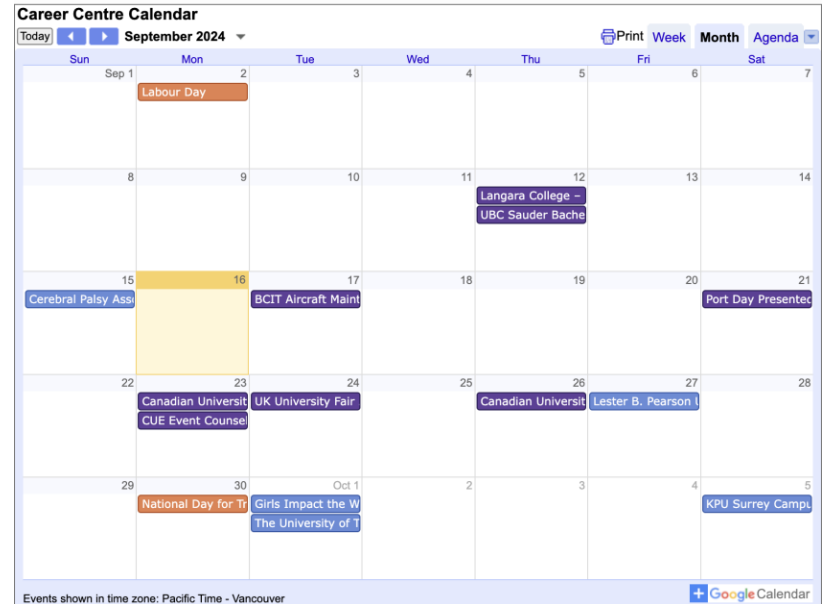
