- Academic Standing: Students must fulfill all academic requirements to attend graduation events.
- **Behaviour:** Students are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that demonstrates positive decision making which aligns with PRIDE behaviour and our District Code of Conduct.
- **Upcoming Events:** Winter Formal will take place on January 23, 2025 and Graduation Dinner and Dance will take place on June 26, 2025. Additional details will be provided closer to the date.
