#### 2025-2026 PROGRAM PLANNING: Feb. 6-19

Students in Grades 8-11 received their program planning session with counsellors on February 5th. There will be a Gr. 8-11 Caregiver Information Night at 7:15pm February 13th. We encourage caregivers to attend and ask questions. Counsellors and our Career Advisor, Ms. Carter, are available during the day for students to seek out additional support if needed. We ask that you review their course selections together before finalizing their schedule for the next school year. Once courses are identified, we ask students to enter their selections into their MyEd BC account between Feb. 6-19. Timetabling (the number of sections of each course) is based on the course requests made by students in February. It is essential that students consider the task of choosing courses as a major responsibility because the choices that they make determine the master timetable. Once the master timetable is built, course changes become much more difficult; thus, it is very important that the selection of courses be done carefully. Students do NOT need to hand in a paper copy of their requested courses this year.
