SAVE THE DATES:

For McMath students, the celebratory afternoon and evening of **Thursday, June 26th** consists of one non-ticketed event and two separate and ticketed events.

1) The parent-organized Red Carpet Event

Location: McMath Breezeway

Cost: Free, non-ticketed event, costs covered by the DAG ticket sales

2) The school-sponsored Formal Grad Dinner Dance

Attendees: McMath Grade 12 graduates

Cost: TBD by the school soon, tickets will be sold on School Cash Online **Attire:** Formal for grads (same outfit as worn to the Red Carpet event)

3) The parent-organized Dry After Grad (DAG)

Location: McMath rotunda and various wings of the school. No in-and-out privileges

Times: Thursday, June 26th approximately 11:00 pm – 5:00 am Friday, June 27th (overnight) **Attendees:** McMath Grade 12 graduates that also attended the Formal Dinner Dance Event

Cost: \$115 includes red carpet event, bus transportation to/from the dinner dance and the all-night DAG event

Attire: Comfortable casual wear to be dropped off at the Bag Drop-Off

Bag Drop-Off for Dry After Grad

Date: Wednesday, June 25th

Location: McMath, end of B-wing only accessible from the outside by the west parking lot

Times: 9:30 am – 12:30 pm or 3:30 pm – 6:30 pm

What to include: comfortable top, bottoms, socks, shoes, undergarments, sweater or hoodie and a labeled

garment bag and coat hanger to protect your formal wear

What not to include: valuables (money, jewelry, electronics), liquids of any kind, containers

More details for Bag Drop-Off coming closer to the time

Can students choose one June 26th event over the other?

- Students can choose to purchase one ticket and attend the formal dinner/dance only.
- To attend DAG, students must purchase a DAG ticket AND a dinner/dance ticket.
- Students can not purchase a DAG ticket only.

We encourage graduates to attend both the Dinner Dance and DAG to have the full celebratory experience with their entire graduation class.

DAG TICKETS:

- To attend the Red Carpet event, Formal Grad Dinner Dance and the Dry After Grad event, students must purchase BOTH a dinner/dance ticket and a DAG ticket.
- The tickets to the dinner/dance and the DAG are sold separately and organized by different groups.

DAG tickets are available on McMath's School Cash Online. The \$115 ticket (you can pay in 3 separate installments or add all 3 installments into the cart to pay for the entire ticket at once) gets your grad into an overnight fun, safe, alcohol-free party that includes lots of food and entertainment. Tickets for the school-sponsored formal dinner/dance at Pat Quinn Restaurant, Tsawwassen Springs will be available shortly.

Please contact Mr. Johnstone, Principal, by email if your grad cannot afford the tickets to this celebration as it is our goal to have all grads included in this special event.

DAG DONATIONS:

There are several ways to make a donation to DAG 2025:

- 1) Monetary donations of any amount are greatly appreciated and will be used to offset the rising costs of food, entertainment and transportation or to purchase necessary supplies:

 - Donors will receive a tax receipt for this donation

- 2) Cash or Cheques made out to McMath Secondary school and specified for DAG (not eligible for a tax receipt)
- 3) Donating food items or discounted food items to be enjoyed by the students
 - Some examples of food donations include pizza, coffee, fruit trays, sushi, decorated sugar cookies, pop and gift cards to grocery stores
- 4) Donating a prize item that will be awarded to grads as part of the activities throughout the evening
 - Some examples of prize donations donated last year include gift cards to local businesses, JBL speakers, restaurant gift cards and fitness memberships
