# STUDENTS WITH EMERGING OR INCOMPLETE PROGRESS / AT RISK INTERIM REPORTS

Final evaluations of student learning for Semester 2, will be at the end of June 2025. Prior to the end of the semester, a small number of students will have received an "At-Risk Interim" because they are not meeting expectation in their course and are at risk of not meeting the Course Standards. These "At-Risk Reports" will detail the learning that must be demonstrated to successfully meet the "Ministry Standards" for the course and thus successfully complete the course. The expectation is that students will engage in the steps necessary to remove their incomplete standing. Some teachers may have already communicated incomplete progress with students and caregivers
