2025-2026 PERSONAL LEARNING TIME (PLT) INFORMATION

All secondary schools in the Richmond School District have moved their PLT to the second period of the day. This adjustment offers better support for students in accessing the learning opportunities available during PLT. PLT at McMath will take place on Tuesday and Thursdays. PLT for this school year begins on Tuesday, Sept. 9th. During the scheduled PLT times on Sept. 9th, 11th, and 16th, all students will report to their homeroom classes. During these three homeroom sessions, all students and staff will engage in school wide activities to set up PLT for the year. Included in this will be activities focused on McMath PRIDE, PLT structures and expectations, as well as how students can view and sign up for the sessions using the online platform. Students will be required to use their Richmond School District login credentials to access the online system and register. We strongly recommend that students have that information ready for September 9^{th} . Participation in PLT at school will be mandatory for all students and attendance will be taken. Beginning with the September 18th PLT, students will be able to select the sessions that they would like to attend. SCHOOL START TIME

As we start this school year, as a school community, we would like to continue to focus on supporting our students' learning and emphasize the importance of punctuality to ensure a successful and productive day for everyone. Classes begin promptly at 8:30am. To support out school's goal of maintaining a structured learning environment, we kindly request your assistance in ensuring that students arrive at school on time.

If you are driving your teen to school for pick up or drop off, we recommend avoiding the peak rush times (8:15am-8:30am and 2:45-3pm) as much as possible.

Arriving on time helps students settle in, focus, and make the most of their learning experience.

LOCKERS

Lockers are available for students to sign up for online. Students will need to use their Richmond School District login credentials to access the system. A number of students have signed up for lockers. If your child would still like to sign up for a locker, the attached "Locker Sign Up - A Guide for Students" contains information about how to do this. Please let us know if you need any assistance.

STUDENT VEHICLE REGISTRATION

Students who are licensed to drive and would like to park a vehicle at school during the school day are required to complete and submit a McMath vehicle registration form (attached). Once completed this form must be submitted to the school's main office before parking at the school. These forms are also available in the main office. Student and parent signatures are required on the form. After the form has been submitted and reviewed, students will be contacted with confirmation of the status of their vehicle registration. Once approved, students may only park in their parking lot along the east side of the school next to the gyms. Please remember that driving is a privilege and it is expected that all drivers will obey all driving rules and regulations as set out by the Province of British Columbia. Thank you for doing your part to help keep our school grounds safe for everyone!

STUDENT SCHEDULES

Our current timetable was built based on our enrollment last Spring and student course requests. While the majority of students have received all their primary course requests, some students may have received their alternate requests due to limited number of sections or timetable conflicts. As our Counselling Team continues to work through course corrections, student requests for course corrections will only be considered for strong educational reasons as we have limited flexibility in our timetable. Students are to continue attending the courses as scheduled until a counsellor confirms whether the changes were able to be made or not. We appreciate everyone's flexibility and patience.
