Official Transcripts & STS

- Within Canada, the Student Transcript Service (STS) electronically sends your transcript to the institutions you applied.
- Transcripts can be accessed at <u>www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca</u> using your BCeID. Students make an account BCeID.

Most BC institutions rely on the electronic information that McMath forwards to the Ministry of Education. Some scholarships and specialized programs require an unofficial OR **official** (stamped and sealed in an envelope) school transcript. These can be ordered from the office by filling in a transcript request form. There is a \$5.00 charge. Please allow **at least 2 days**.

Sending Transcripts

- The Ministry of Education provides an online "order form" where you give permission to allow them to forward your grades to Post-Secondary institutions immediately or more commonly in March/April. Early admissions is sent earlier in January.
- Your 2nd term report card information in May and final grades in July will be sent. Deadlines for having this complete vary. Some Eastern universities have transcript deadlines earlier than the Ministry of Education can provide, so you may have to order and upload your transcript.
- You will need a **BCeID** from https://www.bceid.ca to complete your PSI Choices form at www.studenttranscripts.gov.bc.ca

 (4 6 Gr. 12 courses, Gr. 11 courses)
 - Interest exploration/Career research/program research/PSI
 - "Profiles" supplemental, personal profile
 - Scholarship essays
 - Sport recruitment

How to Apply...

- 1. Submit an application (s)
 - -You can save your application and return to it later
 - -supporting documents sent later by STS or uploading academic transcript
 - -spend time on any supplemental /personal profile (NO RUSH!)
- 2. Review your application and any documents ~ ask for help, readers
- 3. The waiting process to receive a "conditional" offer can be difficult and requires patience
 - -offers may come in late Feb, April and May
- 4. Apply for housing early!!

Post Secondary

"Keep Calm AND Carry On"....we are here to support

Applications typically open in early October. Some institutions have set days each year, for example Langara and KPU applications open as of Oct. 1. Deadlines for application is usually in January or February, and varies with institution and program. For non-competitive programs at VCC, BCIT, Douglas or Langara, important to apply as early as possible.

Some admissions are based on the academic transcript only (highly competitive). Some admissions consider academic transcript PLUS an academic profile (e.g. supplemental application, personal profile) for a holistic approach for evaluation – a "broad-based application". *Quality* of application is reviewed.

SUPPLEMENTAL DOCUMENTATION

In addition to your academic performance, Canadian universities will sometimes consider supplementary information such as a written personal profile, resume, impact statement, a video or a portfolio. Recommendations or reference letters are generally not required.

Supplemental Information Includes:

Personal essay outlining WHO YOU ARE, special aptitudes or interests

Extra-curricular activities

Academic achievements

Teamwork skills

Leadership

Accomplishments, engagement, problem solving, resilience



English Language Requirements

Some schools will require you to meet English Language Proficiency requirements. Assessments such as the LPI, Langara English Test (LET), or the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL).

*Check specific post-secondary college/university websites for language requirements and options.




