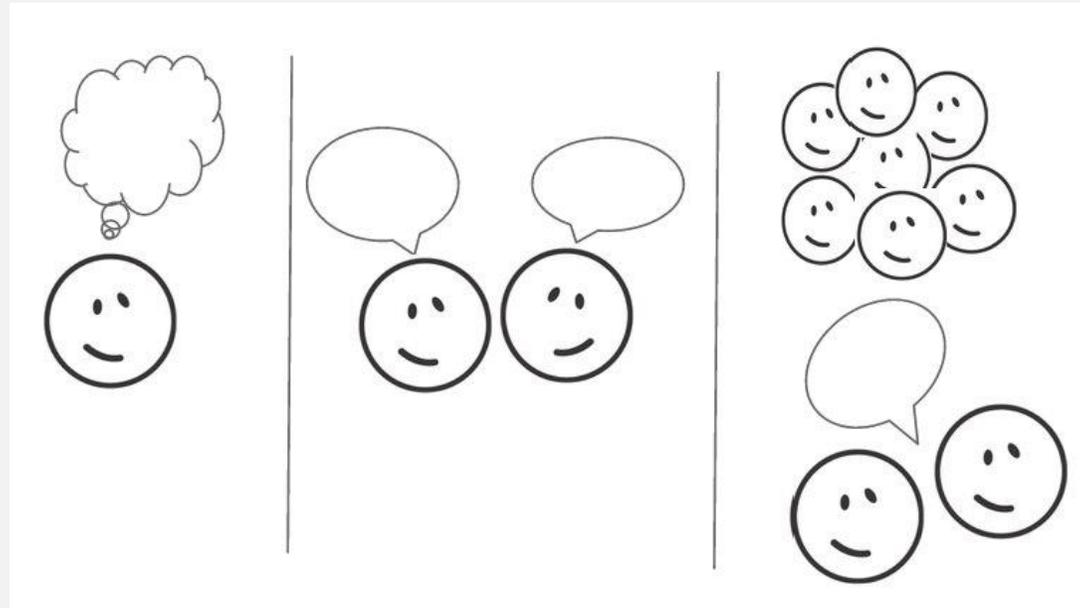

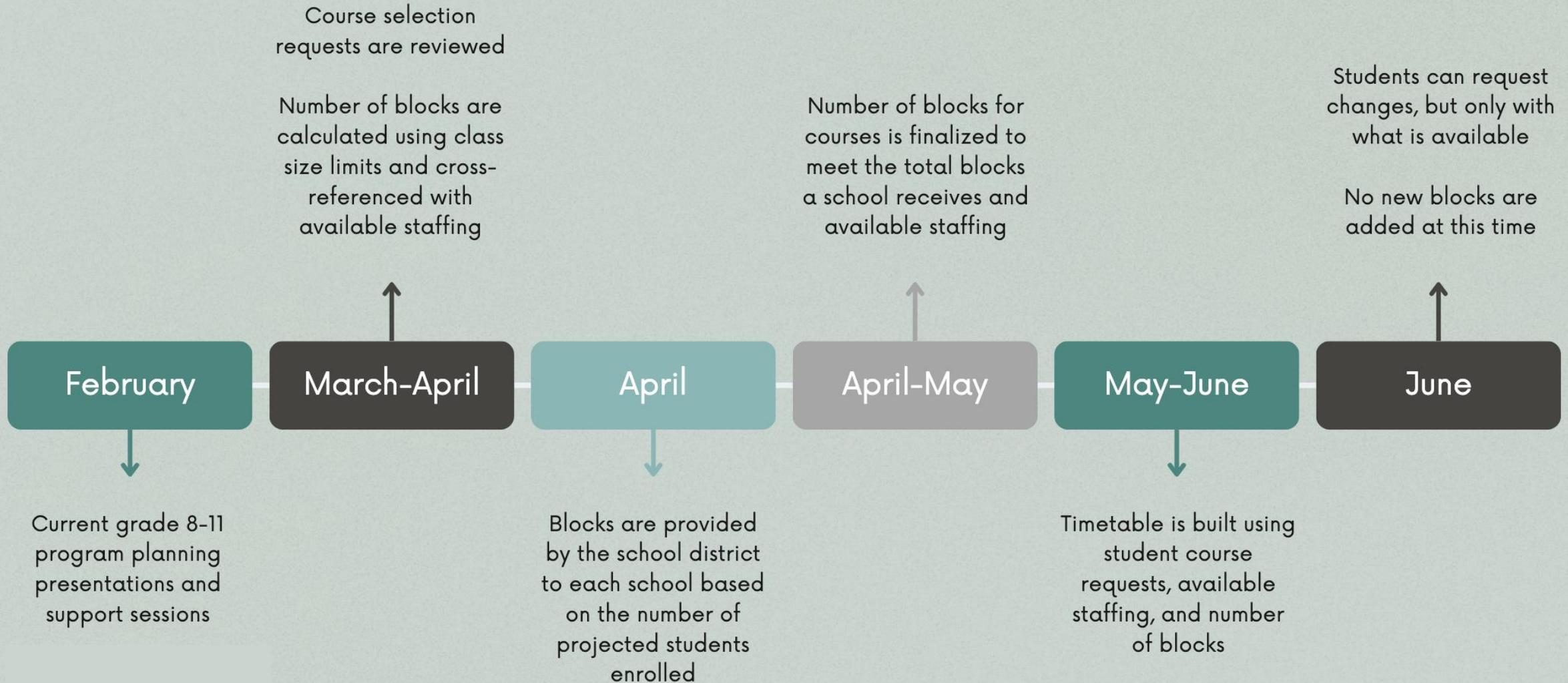

Evaluation of all approved Grade 11 and 12 courses, with emphasis on specific course requirements of the particular faculty of program

Minimum of 5 approved academic Grade 12 courses, including English 12

- 70% in Math 11 or 12
