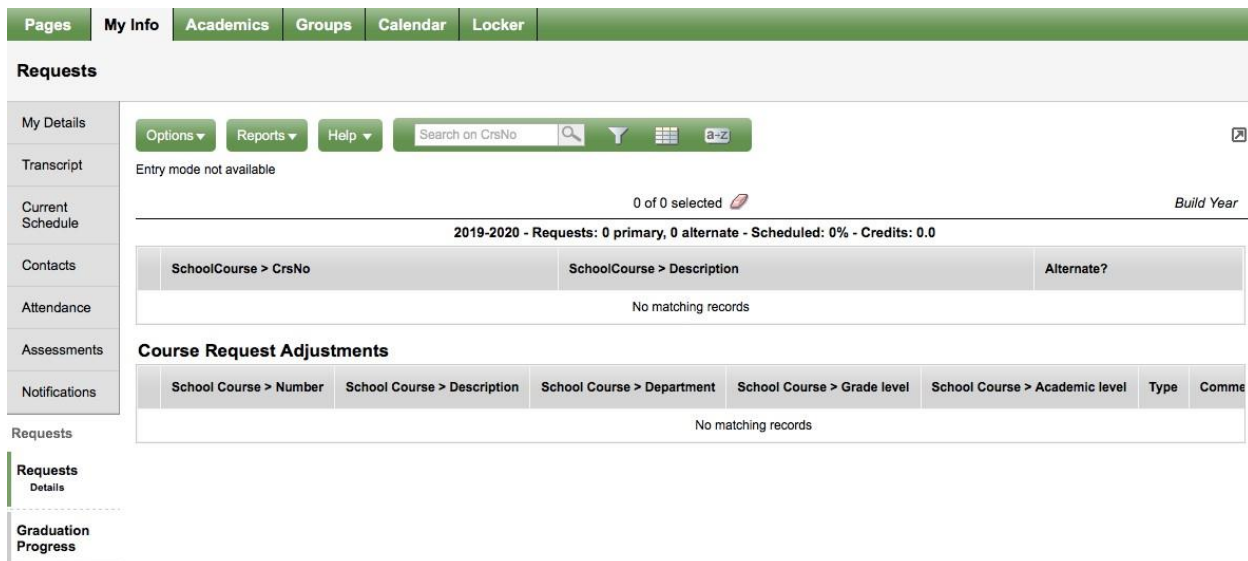
STEP 3: ENTER YOUR COURSE SELECTION INTO MYEDUCATION BC

- Click on the **My Info** Top Tab. Then go to the **Requests** Side Tab. You will see the following screen:



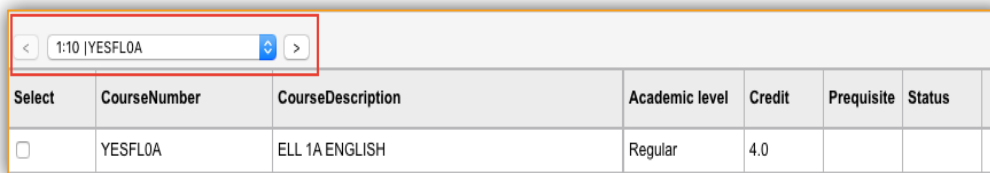
This window has three different sections:
