General Account Update:

- Profit from Christmas chocolate (Purdys) fundraiser: \$3,326.95
- Current general account balance reported.
- Planned expenditures:
 - \$1,500 allocated for upcoming Grade 12 scholarship
 - Approximately \$2,500–\$3,000 allocated for Teacher Appreciation Lunch in late June
- Additional fundraising will be required to support initiatives for the next school year.

Gaming Account Update:

- Opening balance: \$24,151.42
- Wishlist reimbursements processed in December
- Current balance reported at approximately \$15,160.57

No concerns were raised regarding the financial report. The Treasurer was acknowledged for strong fundraising results.

6. PAC/Committee Update:

a. PAC:

- An in-person PAC board gathering was recently held to start the 2026 year
- Positive feedback was shared regarding the value of in-person connection.
 - Several PAC members will not be returning next school year to the PAC as their children are in Grade 12.
 - Parents are encouraged to consider joining PAC for the upcoming school year

to ensure continuity, support grant applications, and maintain fundraising and school support initiatives.

- Recruit PAC members for the 2026–2027 school year.
- Prepare and circulate volunteer sign-up for Dry After Grad (mid-March).
- Continue monitoring fundraising needs for next year’s planning cycle.

b. DAG:

- January meeting completed.
- Decorations planning underway, including measurements of school spaces.
- Deposits paid for:
 - Entertainment
 - Transportation (bus services)
- Event planning is currently on track.
- Parent volunteers will be required both in the days leading up to the event and on Dry Grad night.
- Volunteer sign-up information expected mid-March.

Members highlighted the positive impact of Dry Grad and encouraged participation.

c. Fundraising:

- The Christmas chocolate fundraiser generated over \$3,000 in profit and was considered highly successful.
- Meridian Meats gift card fundraiser is currently active.
- Information is available via the PAC Instagram page.
- This fundraiser provides community value while supporting PAC initiatives.

Key Financial Priorities Identified:

- Grade 12 scholarship funding
- Teacher Appreciation Lunch (June)
- Sustaining funds for next academic year programs and grants.
- To get Gaming Grants for the 2026-2027 school year (estimated \$20,000+), the government requires a complete PAC Board to be elected at the May 2026 Annual General Meeting.
