b. ***Part 2: Pick up a District Authority Explanation of Excellence form in the office or access it on-line. Fill in how you excel in the area, and get the teacher who can verify/confirm your excellence (the teacher whose name you entered on the application) to sign. RETURN the form to the office by Monday, May 4 at 4:00 PM. Fill in only each area you identified in your application***
