1. A sealed Diploma Verification Report (if the school is on MyEd) or a sealed transcript of marks and the most recent report card (if the school is not on MyEd)
2. A covering letter

Scholarship Application 2026**

1. To be eligible for a CUPE 716 Scholarship, one of the applicant's parents or legal guardian must be a member of CUPE Local 716.
2. This round of scholarships is intended for students graduating in June of 2026
3. Four Scholarships each will be awarded. Two scholarships are for academic ability, one for Trades, and one for Fine Arts. One of the academic scholarships is known as the Reynold Sokolik Memorial Scholarship and one of the Trades/Fine Arts scholarships is known as the Wally Wenn Memorial Scholarship.
4. An awarded scholarship can be held in trust for up to three (3) years.
5. To redeem a scholarship the winner must provide proof of payment to a post-secondary education institution.
6. The final selection will be made by CUPE 716 Trustees, and the successful candidates will be notified on or before May 29, 2026
