- Completion of any online course– Check your course/mark on your transcript!
- *TVR sessions with Counsellors available in early Oct & Apr
Listen to announcements/watch email.*

Official Transcripts & STS

- Within Canada, the **Student Transcript Service (STS)** electronically sends your transcript to the institutions you applied.
- Transcripts can be accessed at www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca using your **BCeID** (see next section). Students make an account BCeID.
- Most BC institutions rely on the electronic information McMath forwards to the Ministry of Education. Some scholarships and specialized programs require an unofficial OR **official** (stamped and sealed in an envelope) school transcript. These can be ordered from the office by filling a transcript request form. There is a \$5.00 charge. Please allow **at least 2 days**.

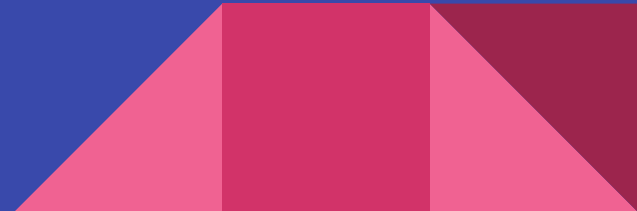

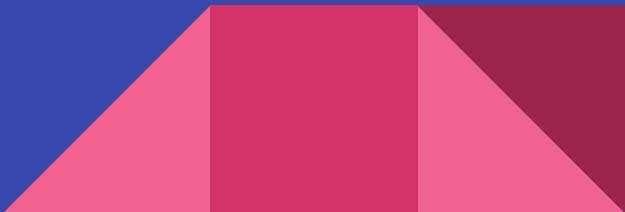

How to Apply...

1. Submit an application (s)
 - You can save your application and return to it later
 - supporting documents sent later by **STS** or **uploading** academic transcript
 - spend time on any supplemental /personal profile (NO RUSH!)
 2. Review your application and any documents ~ ask for help, readers
 3. The waiting process to receive a “conditional” offer can be difficult and requires patience
 - offers may come in late Feb, April and May
 4. Apply for Housing

"Keep Calm AND Carry On"....we are here to support

*Applications typically open in the early Fall. Langara and KPU applications open as of Oct. 1. UBC/SFU opens soon.

*Deadline for application is usually in January or February, and varies with institution and program.

*Non-competitive programs at VCC, Kwantlen or Langara, important to apply as early as possible.

*Some admissions are based on academic transcript assessment only (highly competitive). Some admissions consider academic transcript PLUS an academic profile (e.g. supplemental application, personal profile) for holistic approach for evaluation – a “broad-based application” and **quality** of application reviewed.

SUPPLEMENTAL DOCUMENTATION

In addition to your academic performance, Canadian universities will sometimes consider supplementary information such as a written personal profile, resume, impact statement, a video or a portfolio. Recommendations or reference letters are generally not required.

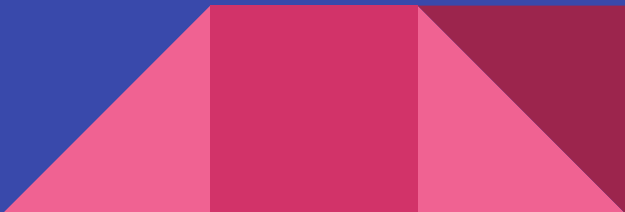
